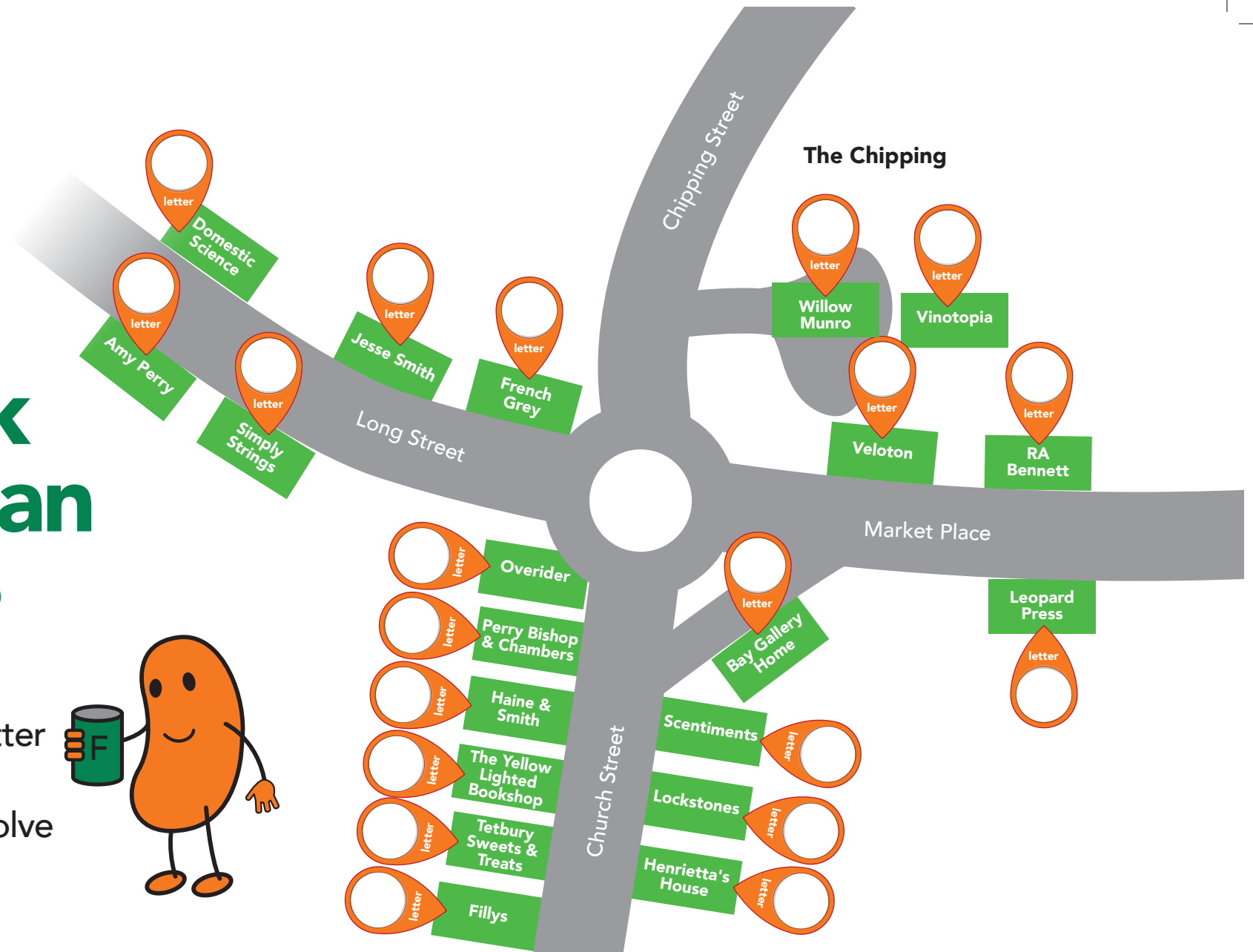
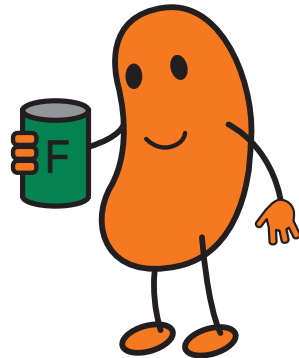


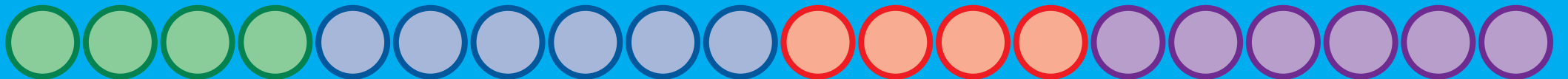


Foodbank Baked Bean Trail 2016

(Each word is colour coded)



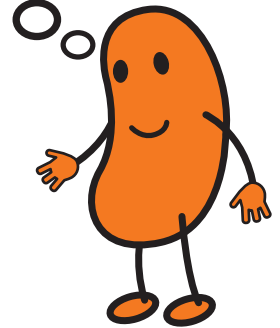
What is a Foodbank?

The Foodbank provides 3 days of emergency food to help local families who are in a crisis.

How do you get help?

You need to have a voucher to get food. Vouchers are provided from people who help us, like Romney House Surgery, Local Schools, St Mary's Day Centre, Save 'n' Borrow Children's Centre, Health Visitors, and Local Churches. They will ask a few questions and then issue a voucher. Your grown-up then brings the voucher and we will support with food, advice. You can have a drink, a biscuit and a play!

How many people does Cirencester Foodbank help?

Last year we supported around 2,000 local people in Cirencester, Tetbury, Fairford and villages. Nearly half were children.
