Overview of the role: Cirencester Foodbank provides three day emergency food parcels for people in crisis, working in partnership with organisations across the community. The delivery driver role is fundamental to our temporary home delivery model.

- Transporting food parcels to client homes using Foodbank-owned van
- · Carrying heavy boxes of canned foods
- Regular loading and unloading of the van
- Regular van driving across the local area
- Collecting food donations from collection points such as community centres and churches around the local area
- Delivering food donations to the warehouse
- Such other duties and responsibilities as shall be requested from time to time by the Foodbank Manager.
